Registration

THIS EVENT IS ONLINE PRE-REGISTRATION ONLY

Riders can register through the British Cycling website.

International riders can register through the online entry system but will need to send their race licence to via e-mail to: bmx@britishcycling.org.uk, in order to receive the passcode to enter.

THE CLOSING DATE FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION IS MONDAY BEFORE THE EVENT AT 11AM

LATE ENTRIES FOR CHALLENGE RIDERS: will be accepted until 9am on the Thursday prior to the event at double entry fee and via the BC entry system (payment at the event is not accepted).

LATE ENTRIES FOR CHAMPIONSHIP RIDERS: will be accepted until 8am on the Saturday of an event at double entry fee and via the BC entry system (payment at the event is not accepted).

Single day late entries will not be permitted.

Auto Check In

Riders can "check in" on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Check in will be via a practice lap (with transponder) or manually at admin only during the registration times in the schedule.

Check in will close at 10:30am on Saturday therefore riders must have completed at least one practice / check in lap prior to this. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that they have checked in. Any rider who does not check in will be removed from the event.

Please see the Manchester Indoor Technical Document for specific times for the Manchester Indoor rounds, as this process differs from the outdoor.

A list of the pre-registered riders will be posted online on Sqorz – ALL riders must check and report any discrepancies or issues to the admin team.

It is the rider/parent's responsibility to check their entry and report any errors to Race Administration no later than 45 minutes before the start of racing. No changes will be accepted after that time and any incorrect entries may be disqualified. A rider racing without a working transponder will not be scored.

Riders must be registered to their team on Sqorz before the start of the series in order to receive series standing points for that team. Once the first round has been completed, it is not possible to change team or add teams to riders from a points perspective.

Riders will not be permitted to practice on Saturday and Sunday unless their transponder is attached to their bike.

Transponders

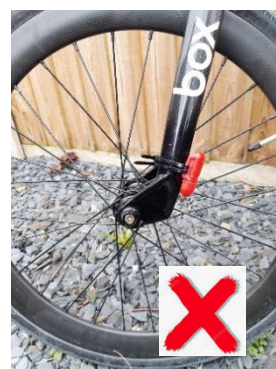
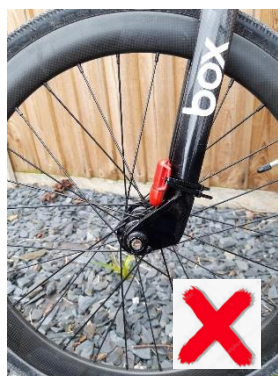
The National Series uses a transponder scoring system featuring MY SQORZ online race software and MyLaps transponders.



All riders competing the in the National Series **MUST** have an active MyLaps Pro Chip Flex transponder registered to each bike they compete on – Transponders cannot be shared in any circumstances at an event. Any other type of transponder is not allowed. Those riders riding on both cruiser and 20” must have a transponder for each bike.

Please ensure that your transponder has been activated before the event.

It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is fitted correctly to their bike. Transponders should be fitted to the left-hand side of the forks, as far down the fork leg as possible. Transponders can only be fitted to the outside or inside of the forks. Any other position will be deemed as cheating, and this may result in disqualification.

Host Club Practice Session

Friday practice sessions will be available and will be ran by the host clubs. Information for each venue will be made available on the event page ahead of the event.

Regulations

Rules – National BMX Race Series

- 1) The youngest category for riders using clip-less pedals is 13 years or above.
- 2) All competing riders must have a valid Silver or Gold membership and a current British Cycling licence. No licence = No race
- 3) Non-UK riders must have a valid 2025 UCI affiliated licence. Failure to show licence if requested will result in the rider being withdrawn.

- 4) BC BMX racing regulations apply to all non SX events. The race format will be as per National Series Regulations.
- 5) Superclass and Junior will race from the 8m hill (where available) and use all pro sections.
- 6) Championship women will race from the 8m hill (where available) and challenge sections.
- 7) All other categories will race from the 5m hill and only use the challenge sections.

Number Plates

The required background colour must be clearly visible around and in-between all numbers used. The background colour must not be cut down to follow the contours of a number but may be cut to follow the design of the number plate or to form one straight line defining the edge of the background.

Side number plates are mandatory. Black numbers on a white background must be used and be clearly visible. These numbers must match that on the front plate and be on both sides of the bike and not folded or curved.

All riders must compete on their final standing from the 2024 BMX Race National Series (not BC national ranking).

2024 British Champions	01
2024 World finalists	Prefix W
2024 European finalists	Prefix E
Any rider not competing in the 2024 series	Last 3 digits of your BC membership number

Non UK riders – Register on you regular number and race administration will advise you if there needs to be change.

Championship class riders may elect to ride on their authorised career number.

Male	Yellow background – Black numbers
Female	Blue background – White numbers
Cruiser	Red background – White numbers
Elite	White background – Black numbers
Junior	Black Background – White numbers
Superclass and Championship Women	Black on White OR White on Black

Riders number plates must match the number listed on Sqorz. Please ensure you check Sqorz prior to the event to make sure you have the correct plate number. Plates must be matching or have been update on Sqorz prior to check in closing. Failure to do so will result in an official warning with further offences resulting in relegation.

Standings, Rankings and Points

Only riders born 2016 (9) and before will be eligible for a series overall standing.

The overall series standings will be based on a riders best SIX rounds. Please note that in the event of tied points, rounds outside of the six rounds may be used.

Riders will receive points based on overall finishing position of each round. Points available for each round can be found below:
